Dear Parents and Guardians,

Welcome to the Harbor School 2020 Extended School Year Program! We hope that you are having had a restful summer!

Our summer program will run from July 6 – August 14, 2020. We will start the ESY with a Virtual program on July 6 – 10, and July 13 and 14 and continue to provide the Virtual program for those students who will remain remote through August 14. The first day for students participating in-person, will start on July 15.

From July 6 – July 14, all teachers, therapists, and paraprofessionals will provide virtual home instruction and teletherapy in the same manner as was done last school year. Your child will receive lessons and activities on Google Classroom or Class Dojo, as well as Zoom invites to participate in video-conferencing classrooms or therapy sessions. Our paraprofessionals will also participate in the Zoom classrooms, providing support for our students and teachers.

For those students who will remain remote, they will continue to receive the same virtual home instruction and therapy through the end of the ESY program. We have assigned a group of virtual teachers to provide this instruction starting on July 15. These teachers will continue to post assignments on Google Classroom and conduct Zoom video-conferencing classrooms. Our paraprofessionals will also continue to provide virtual support to our students in this model.

For those students who will attend in-person, they have been assigned a classroom teacher and 1:1 paraprofessional support (for those students that require this support). We will continue to provide a fun and functional summer program, while adhering to the health and safety protocols as outline in our COVID Operational Plan.

While these times are unprecedented, the Harbor School team continues to be excited to support the academic and emotionally needs of all our students.

We are looking forward to an amazing summer (both virtually and in-person), as we continue the Harbor School mission and traditions!
